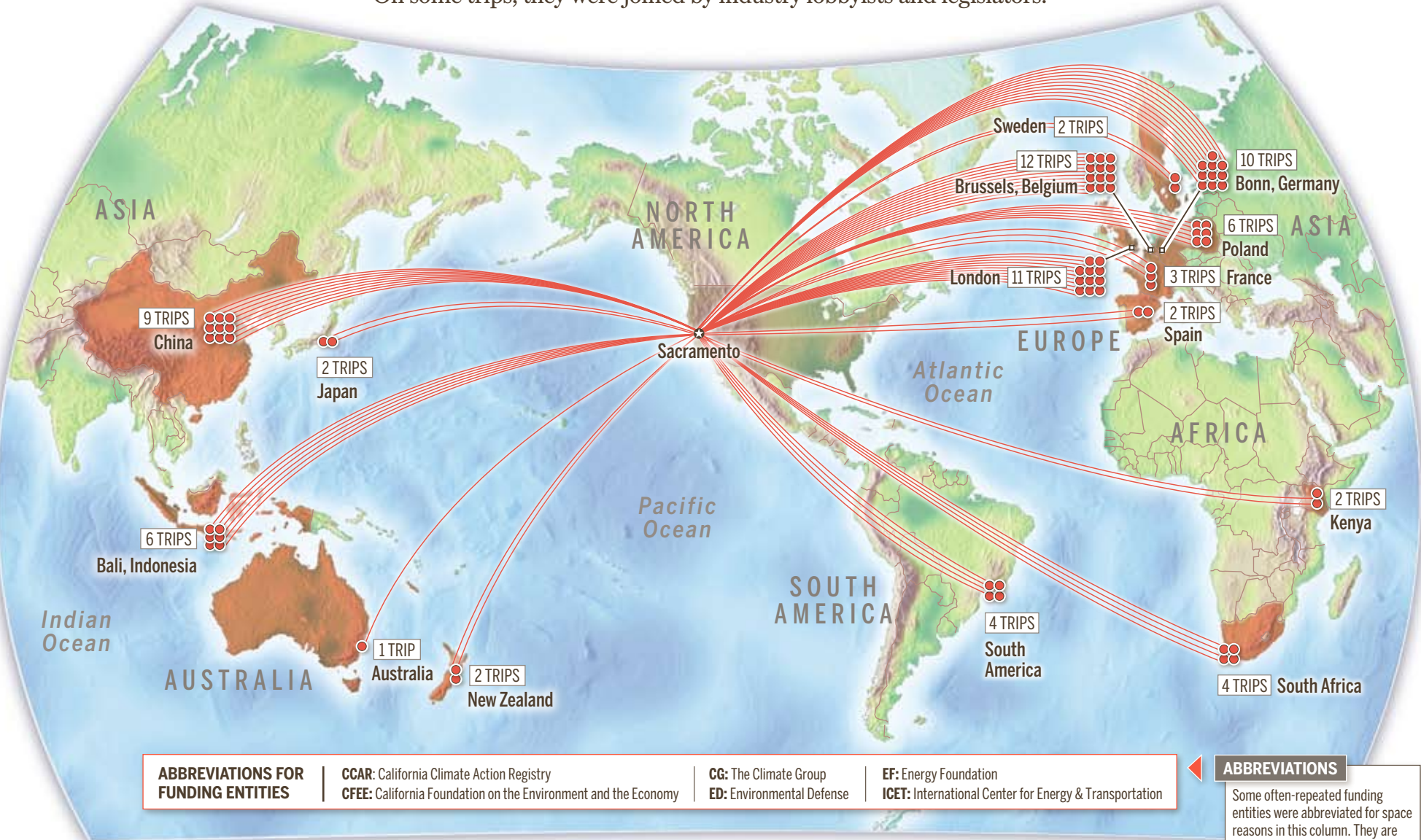


# CALIFORNIA ENERGY OFFICIALS TRAVEL THE GLOBE

Many of California's top climate and energy officials have traveled the world on trips organized – and paid for – mostly by nonprofit organizations that receive funding from major greenhouse gas polluters, including oil and power companies. Between 2006 and 2008, The Bee found, they logged more than 700,000 air miles and touched down in 17 nations for conferences, study trips, workshops and speeches. On some trips, they were joined by industry lobbyists and legislators.

## RECIPIENTS OF FUNDED TRAVEL FROM 2006 THROUGH 2008

Air travel by the 26 current and former officials listed at right released at least 275,000 pounds of CO2 into the atmosphere. Some officials purchased carbon offsets to balance out their emissions – but others did not.
