Welcome to the Local Government Dialogue on the Draft Scoping Plan for AB 32, the CA Global Warming Solutions Act, held August 11-13th.

The Dialogue is now closed. No further messages can be submitted. We are currently compiling a final summary, with the intention of posting this on site on August 20th, at which time it will also be sent to the Air Resources Board.

On August 11-13th, Local Government leaders from across the discussed the Draft "Scoping Plan" put forward by the California Air Resources Board as the implementation roadmap for achieving the climate protection goals as defined in AB 32, the California Global Warming Solutions Act, and specifically how this plan will depend upon the support and engagement of cities and counties in California to achieve the State's climate protection objectives.

The current draft AB 32 Scoping Plan identifies local government climate protection effort for 2 million metric tons (MMTs) of reduced greenhouse gas emissions out of the total 169 MMTs which is the estimated target for achieving the AB 32 goals for cutting California's greenhouse gas emissions to 1990 levels by the year 2020.
