



Texas Triangle


- By **2050** about 35 million people, or 70 percent of the population of Texas, will live in the four metropolitan areas that comprise the **Texas Triangle**.

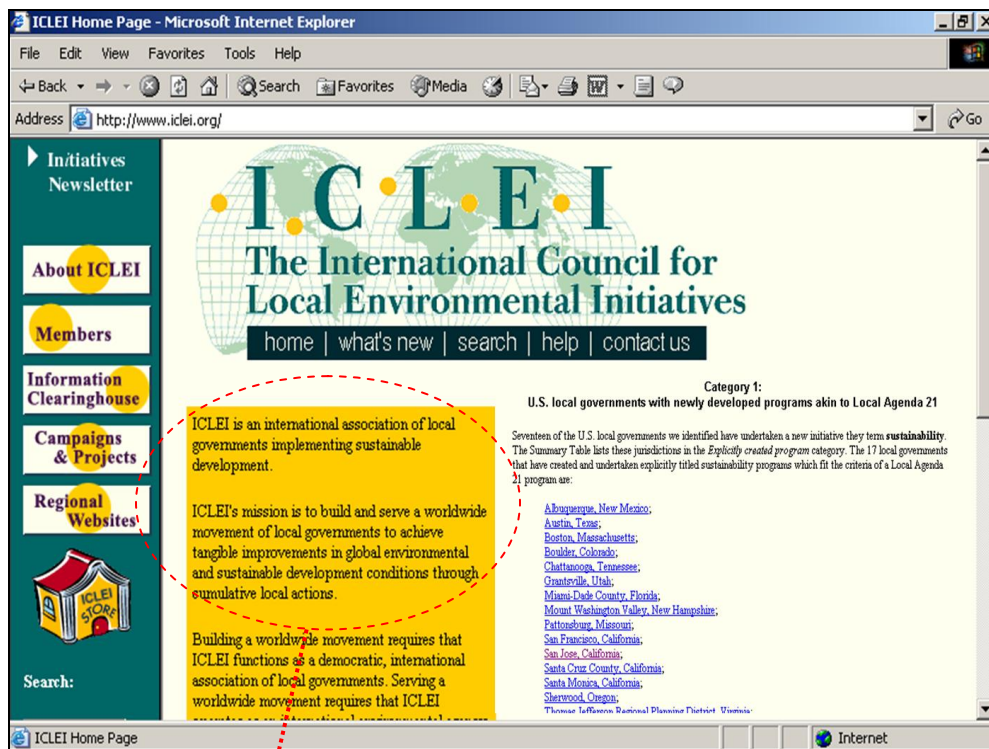

ICLEI is an important NGO that:

It is an extra constitutional level of government that advances globalist objectives.

Sustainable Environmental Excellence

By state statute, the purpose of a council of governments is "to make studies and plans to guide the unified, far-reaching development of the region, eliminate duplication, and promote economy and efficiency in the coordinated development of the region."

In short, *NCTCOG* exists: to advance the globalist goals of regionalizing, to implement a step by step approach to the abolition of private property, to promote the relocation of people from Wildlands and corridor areas to Smart Growth areas, and for the conscription of public private partners – the *mandatory volunteers* of the new fifth column.

Regionalism practiced by the *North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG)* has birthed and administered the Texas Wildlands and Smart Growth policies including the environmental, economic and transportation strategy for the 16-county *North Central Texas* area that includes Fort Worth. NCTCOG is a prototypical Agenda 21 soviet council.

What does “Soviet” mean?

- A soviet is a system of councils that report to an apex council and implement a predetermined outcome, affecting a region or neighborhood often arranged through a process of facilitated consensus.
- Members of a soviet council are chosen by virtue of their willingness to comply with that outcome and their one-mindedness with the group.
- Soviets are the operating mechanism of a government-controlled economy, whether it be socialism or public/private partnerships.

The scary part is that organizations like *NCTCOG* are everywhere. But the battle is always local.

Regionalism is the watchword. It is a core aspect of Sustainable Development. Regionalism might sound benign, but the consequences that come as a result of political regionalism must be understood by freedom loving people or liberty will be trampled. Regionalism is being used to destroy traditional political boundaries and usher in a transformed system of governance that

abolishes private property; a goal of Sustainable Development Agenda 21.

In the words of Charlotte Iserbyt former Department of Education Official, “Regionalism is Communism”. Regionalism is also Fascism. Regionalism erases political boundaries and thus representative government. Regional governance cannot coexist with the American Republic form of government. We can account for much that is wrong today to organizations such as *NCTCOG*.

The purpose is to consolidate (or “collaborate”) the global and regional effort to conspire against the idea of private property. They do this, in part, by advocating and establishing a system of “partners” who will cooperate with the new order.

Vision North Texas:

Vision North Texas is a “private-public partnership...” including “the Urban Land Institute, the North Central Texas Council of Governments, and the University of Texas at Arlington”.



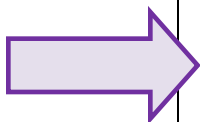

- **Resident Empowerment:** A term used with residents of public housing to make them think that they have some say in and autonomy over their lives; yet it is making them a participant in their own serfdom.
- **Leveraging Resources:** Focuses on collaboration and resource mapping. We've talked about the collaboration part. The resource mapping puts every aspect of a community – its agencies, organizations, businesses and individuals – into a data bank to be held as resources that can be used when needed.

The economics to support this kind of development doesn't exist, but it enables the "sucking up" of the last valueless dollars.

Remaking American Life – Example 2:

Livable Communities = "Smart Growth"; the stacking and packing of human beings in dense cities where people depend on public transportation rather than auto mobility. Trails, rail, and buses alongside government controlled high density housing.





- **Triple the number of bicycle commuters**
- **Decrease the level of bicyclists crashes**
- **Attain official designation** as Bicycle Friendly Community through the *League of American Bicyclists*.
