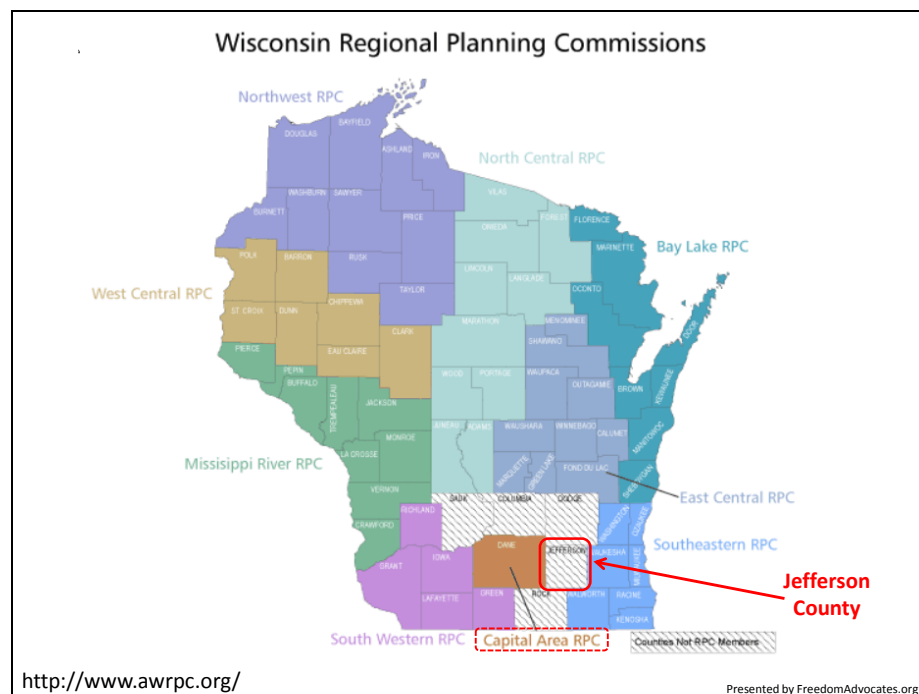
The Globalist invasion has occurred right under our noses. Every county in America has its local Agenda 21 implementation underway.

Here is Margaret Thatcher’s definition of “Consensus”:

“To me consensus seems to be the process of abandoning all beliefs, principles, values and policies in search of something in which no one believes, but to which no one objects—the process of avoiding the very issues that have to be solved, merely because you cannot get agreement on the way ahead. What great cause would have been fought and won under the banner "I stand for consensus"?”

You can learn to break the planned consensus meetings operated through “facilitation” with predetermined outcomes. This is the study that Beverly Eakman has addressed to perfection. Remember, avoiding “consensus” is a first line of defense. Speak out!

Just because Jefferson County isn't part of a COG (called RPCs in Wisconsin) don't think that you aren't being subjected to the regionalists' assault. The prime tool for regionalism is the adoption of Comprehensive Plans. In Jefferson County, your elected officials have brought you that directly.

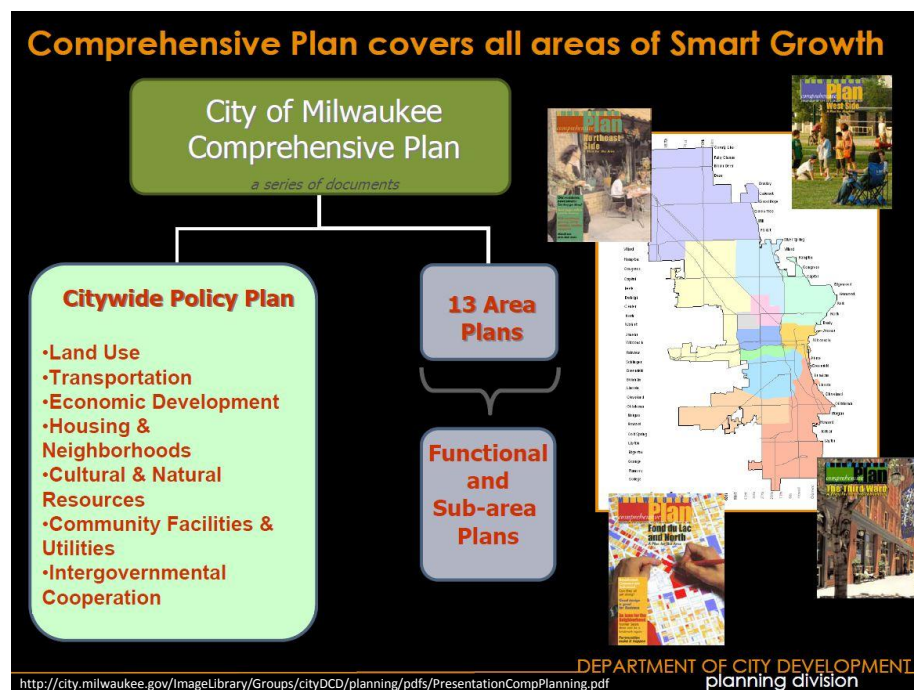

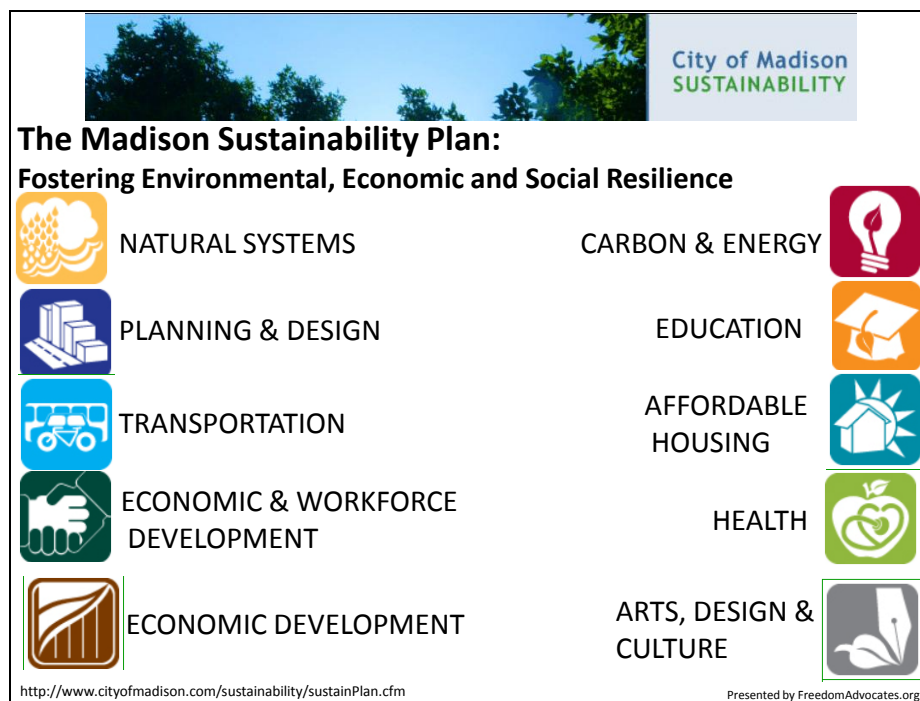

Brundtland is a Norwegian social democratic politician who served three terms as Prime Minister of Norway and has served as the Director General of the World Health Organization. She is now a Special Envoy on Climate Change for the U.N. Secretary General Ban Ki-moon.


We need to wake up, and quickly.



Wisconsin's Forest Sustainability Framework

Linking Monitoring to Action

Wisconsin's Forest Sustainability Framework was developed by the Wisconsin Council on Forestry and supported by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.

Wisconsin's Forest Sustainability Framework (Framework) lays out a **blueprint for gathering data to assess the sustainability of forests in Wisconsin**. The strength of the Framework lies in the fact that it was built by a distinguished group of individuals representing all facets of forestry: private landowner groups, conservation organizations, academic institutions, Native American tribes, industry, government, and non-profits. This is a document for all Wisconsinites, not just for particular groups or agencies.

The *Montreal Process* on criteria and indicators for the conservation and sustainable management of temperate and boreal forests (MP) was launched in 1994 as a response to the Rio Forest Principles and Chapter 11 of Agenda 21.

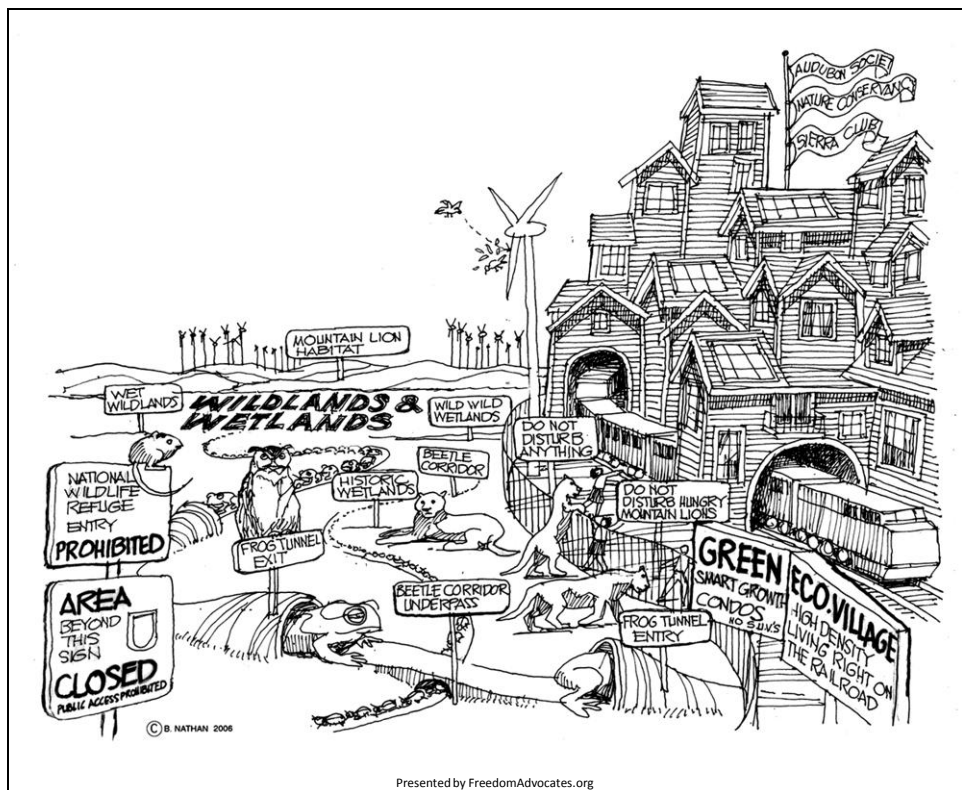
