97 percent of all new households will be accommodated in already urbanized areas, and particularly in cities where residents have access to frequent public transit service. Under this scenario, 70 percent of the growth, or 632,100 new households, will go into places that have been designated 'close to transit' by local jurisdictions.

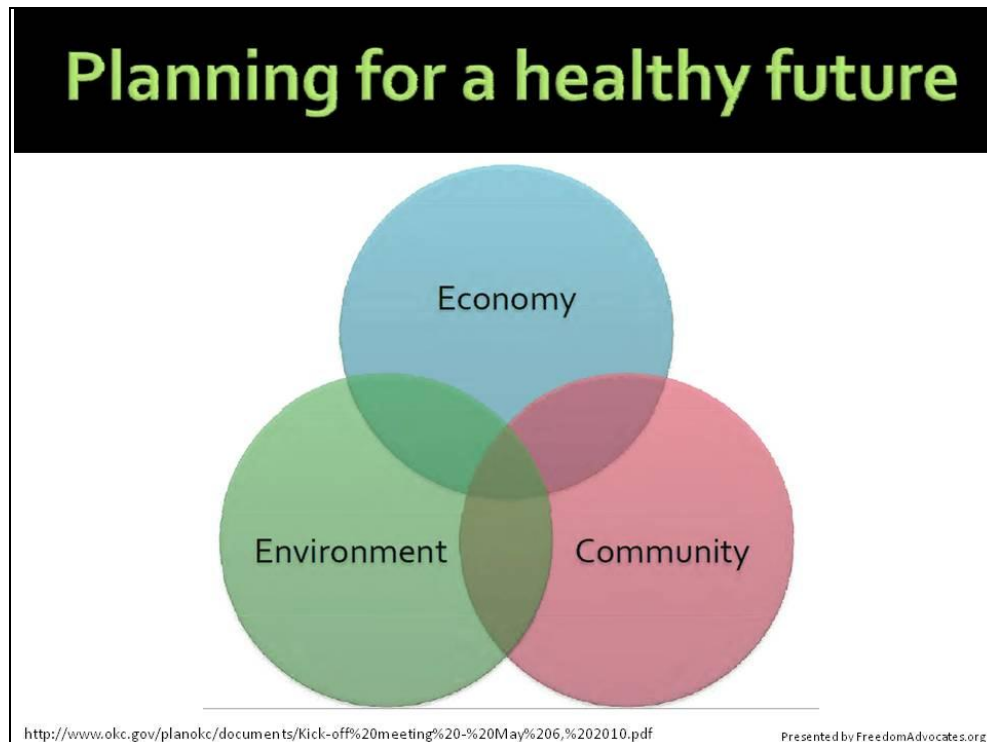
What is planokc?





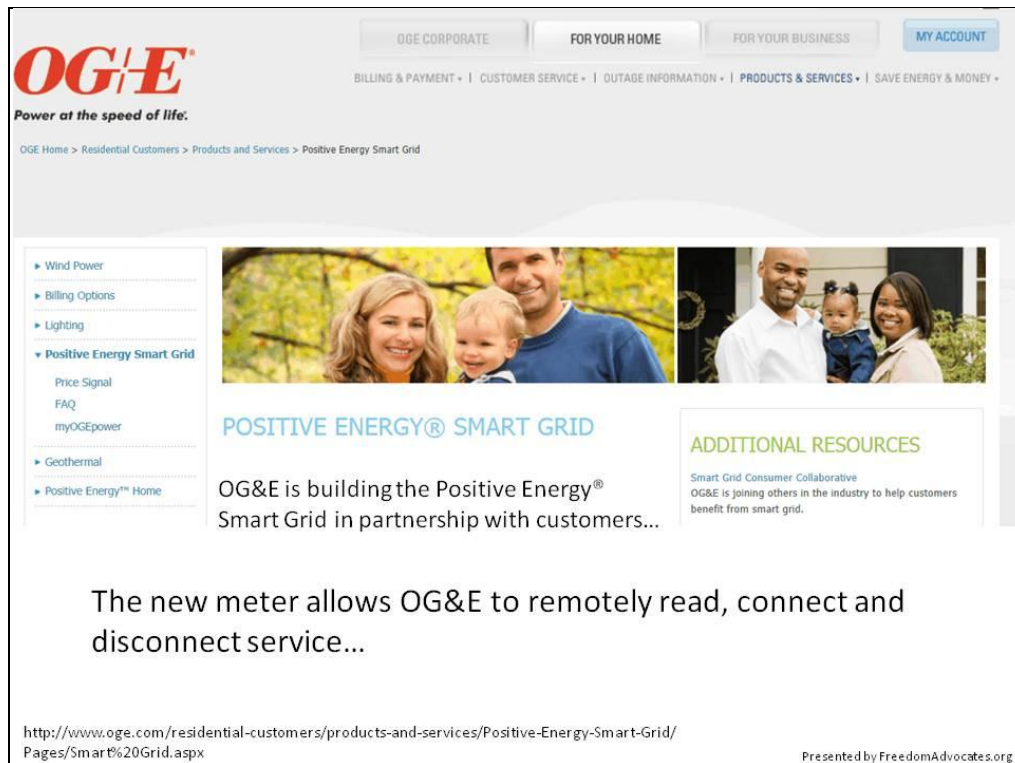
The Office of Sustainability is responsible for enhancing the City's energy efficiency efforts and promoting sustainability throughout the organization and the community.

They'll create their energy efficiency programs by monitoring – individuals and households. How? Through SMART Meters and the Smart Grid.

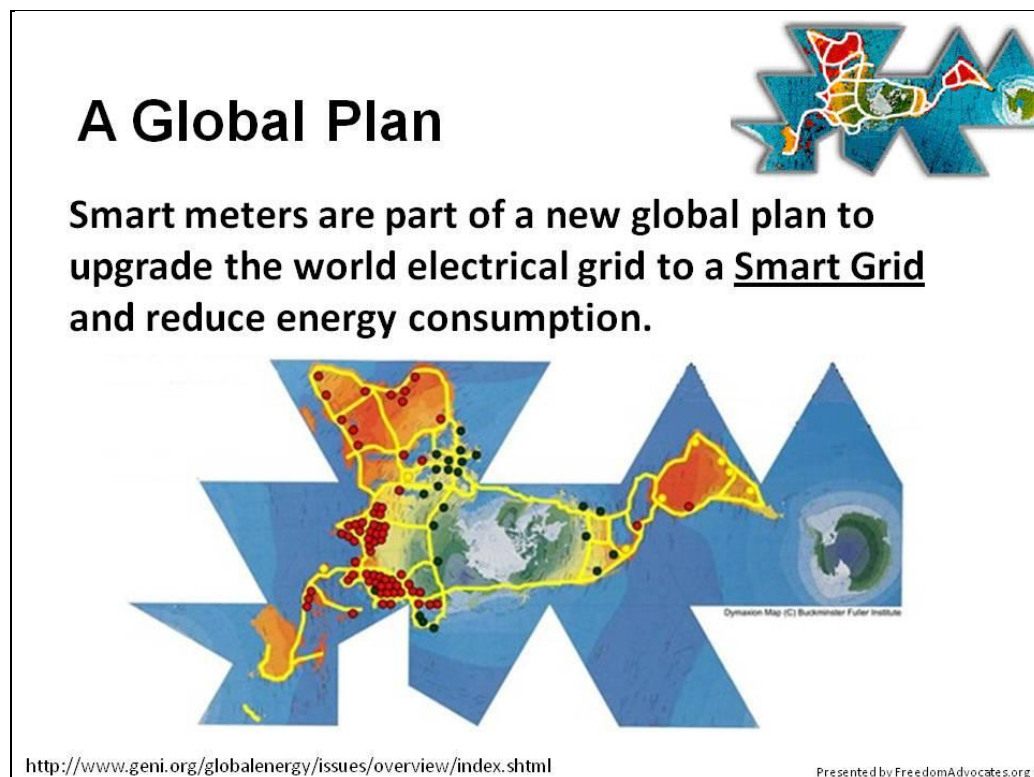


You are going to get the same kind of service that I get from PG&E: shortage, by design! If you don't conserve, the power will go out. If you do conserve, the power will go out.

Utility bills are in the midst of rapidly advancing unit costs. We are being transformed. Can you tell yet?

Your smart meters are tied into a globalist Smart Grid system. It tells the government about all of your uses, and it gives the government the capacity to control your access to and usage of energy.

This is what the global Smart Grid looks like according to the Global Energy Network Institute (GENI):



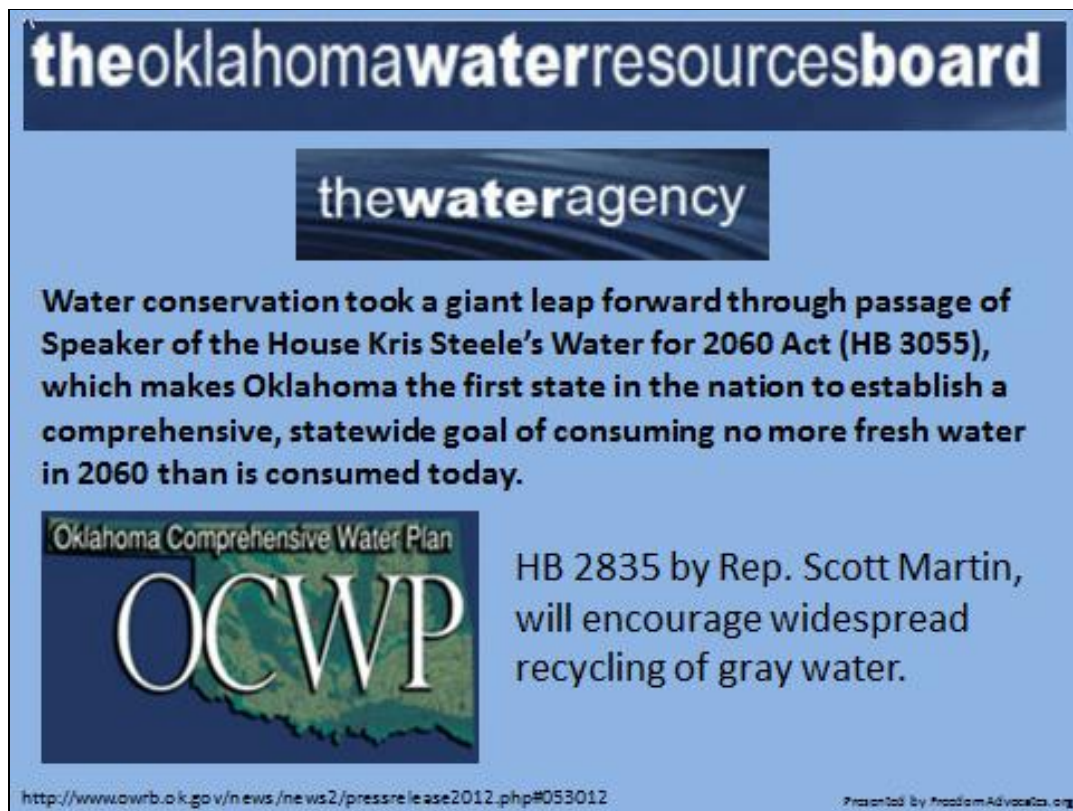
According to the Department of Energy website, “Smart Grid” generally refers to applying computer-based remote control and automation technology to

utility electricity delivery systems. The “grid” amounts to the networks that carry electricity from the plants where it is generated to consumers. It includes adding two-way digital communication technology to devices associated with the grid.

A key feature of the smart grid is automation technology that lets the utility adjust and control each individual device or millions of devices from a central location. The number of applications that can be used on the smart grid once the data communications technology is deployed is growing as fast as companies can create and produce them.

Water policy is going to follow the same “Smart” approach.

Just last month, on May 21, 2012 Oklahoma Governor Mary Fallin signed into law HB 3055, a water bill entitled the *Water for 2060 Act*.



In 2006, the City of Oklahoma City undertook an ambitious planning process to redevelop 750 acres of underutilized land between the core of downtown to the shore of the [Oklahoma River](#).

Envisioned as Core to Shore, efforts are now underway to build and connect a series of neighborhoods, parks, and economic opportunities that will reinvent downtown Oklahoma City, leading to new jobs and a higher quality of life for residents.

Major aspects of the Core to Shore plan include:

- ▶ Creation of a world-class, pedestrian-friendly boulevard
- ▶ Development of a 40-acre central park
- ▶ Development of business, retail and mixed use housing along the central park
- ▶ Building of a Convention Center and Convention Center hotel
- ▶ Relocation of some of the existing businesses and homes in the area


Who gave the federal government “stewardship” over the citizens’ land?

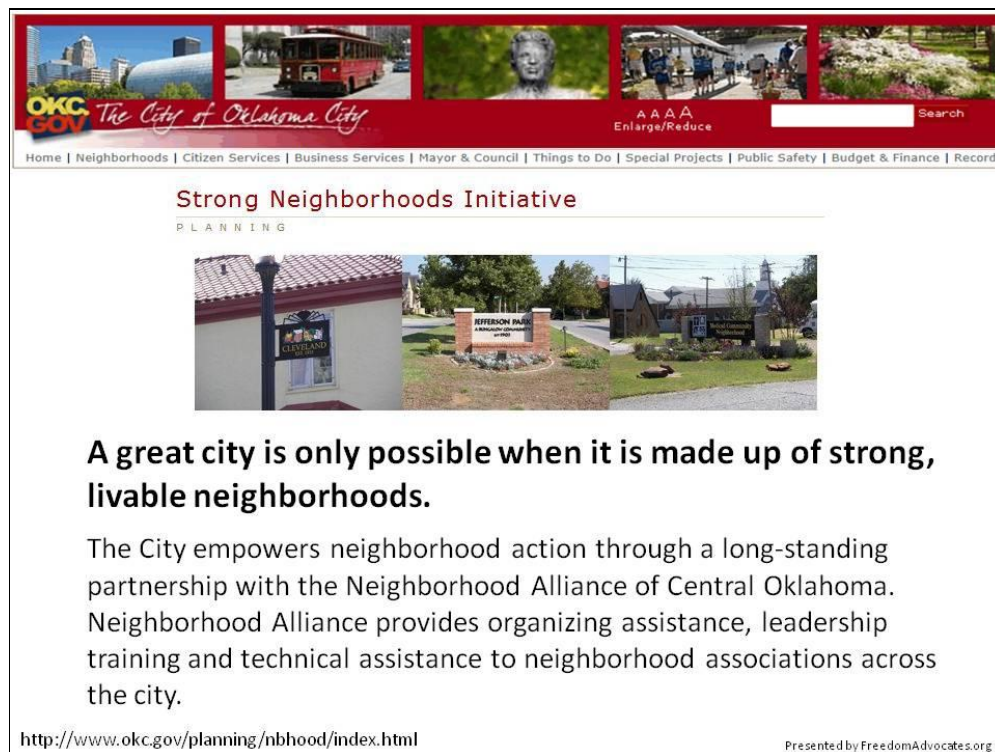
What about private property owners?

What can you do?

ICLEI, and the Central Oklahoma Regional Transit Dialog for what they are: a massive 5th column leading Oklahoma down the path to becoming an outpost of the New Totalitarian World Order.

Remember the essence of your mission:

Restore the principles set forth in the Declaration of Independence –
– protect life, liberty and private property.

Next, don't compromise the principles of freedom. Fight Smart Growth and Wildland projects in your area. Restore the idea of private property.

And then, look behind the Green Mask. Discover the philosophical folly of the environmental movement.

So, what are our demands!

The federal government is where the transformation is coming from. It is now everywhere, including Central Oklahoma. So, take counter-action locally. Local pro-action is our best strategy to stave off world government at this late date.

Get the federal government out of your county and then out of Oklahoma.

- a. This means having your city withdraw from the COG and MPO. Otherwise you have been sovietized.
- b. Kick out of your county:
 - i. The U.S. Forest Service and the USDA
 - ii. The federal Department of Interior
 - iii. The federal Department of Education

Next, remove the Globalists from all local governing boards and substitute them with people who understand the internationalist threat and its Agenda 21 action plan.

Then:

- c. Terminate all contracts and contacts with NGOs.
- d. Remove the ICLEI organization and all policy that resulted from the ICLEI association.

If you understand your area's local Agenda 21 program you can win back your town or neighborhood from Agenda 21's policies. Then you can move on to a broader area. Ultimately people will combine with others working similarly around Oklahoma.

You must expunge Sustainable Development policy from your state's law and out of Oklahoma's bureaucracy.
