

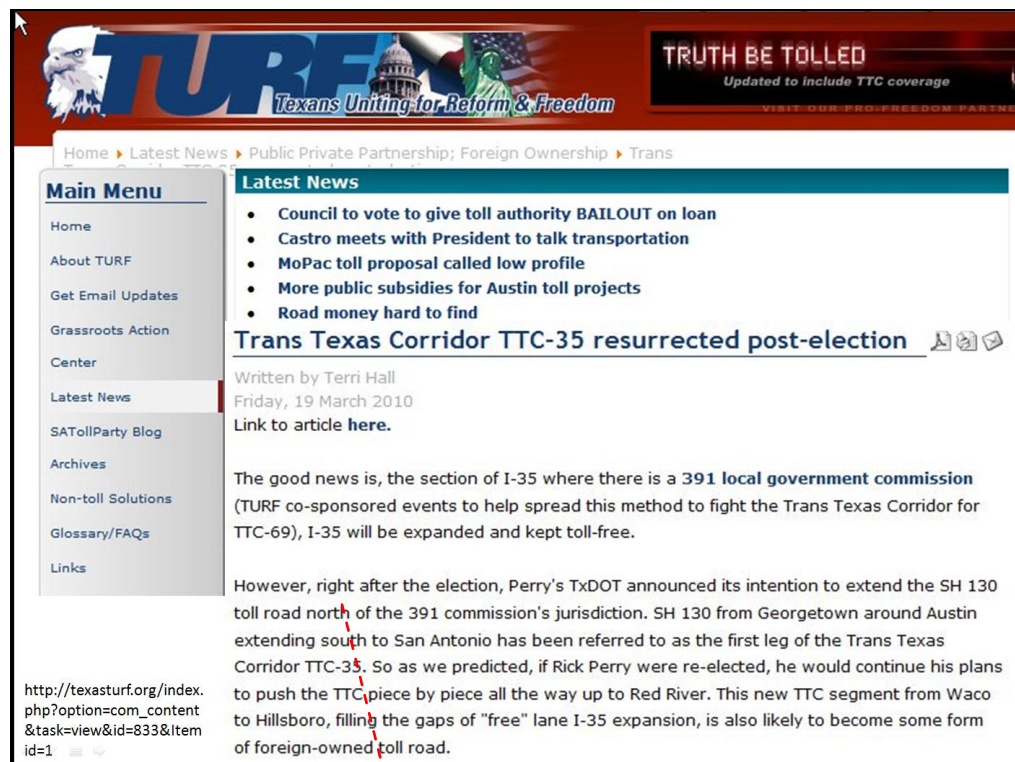
Texas Triangle

By 2050 about 35 million people, or 70 percent of the population of Texas, will live in the four metropolitan areas that comprise the **Texas Triangle**. Three of the nation's 10 largest cities are in the Triangle, including Houston, which has a port that handles more foreign tonnage than any other U.S. port. Efforts to create a **NAFTA superhighway from Mexico to Canada could create a developed corridor through San Antonio, Austin, and Dallas.**



However, right after the election, Perry's TxDOT announced its intention to extend the SH 130 toll road north of the 391 commission's jurisdiction. SH 130 from Georgetown around Austin extending south to San Antonio has been referred to as the first leg of the Trans Texas Corridor TTC-35. So as we predicted, if Rick Perry were re-elected, he would continue his plans to push the TTC piece by piece all the way up to Red River. This new TTC segment from Waco to Hillsboro, filling the gaps of "free" lane I-35 expansion, is also likely to become some form of foreign-owned toll road.

The Texas Department of Transportation reported in July 2010 that the Trans Texas Corridor-35 (TTC-35) was dead. But is it really?

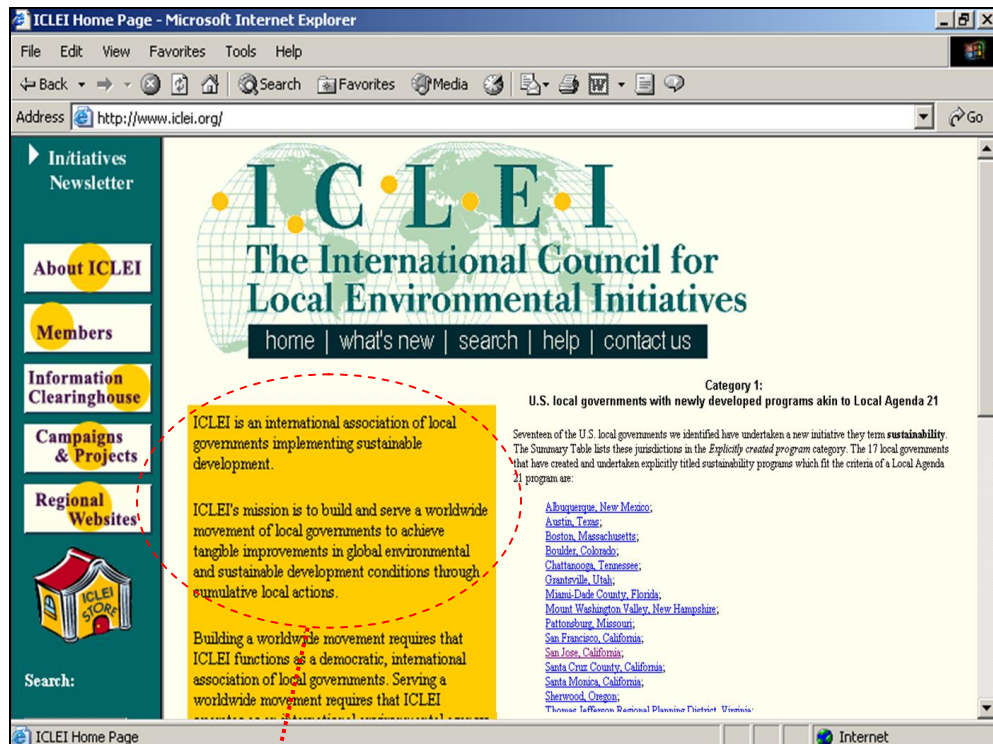

Let's examine aspects of the 'Local Action' Plan.

ICLEI

This is the most vulnerable globalist organization operating in America today.

ICLEI is the international environmental agency for local governments.

ICLEI's mission is to build and serve a worldwide movement of local governments to achieve tangible improvements in global environmental and sustainable development conditions through cumulative local actions.

The full name of ICLEI is “The International Council for Local Environmental Initiatives”. It is also called “Local Governments for Sustainability”.

ICLEI is an important NGO that:

- Closely ties policy to man-made Global Warming and climate change.
- Has formed an international Congress filled with city and county representatives. This Congress acts as a shadow World Government.
- Directs Community Development and other local agencies and provides statutory and regulatory provisions that implement Sustainable policy locally.

Local tax funds pay the contract fee. Agenda 21 policy-making is fully embedded upon ICLEI’s arrival. At least 600 cities, including Bloomberg led New York City, from all across the nation, have ICLEI contracts. Local governments have been hijacked by world government agents.

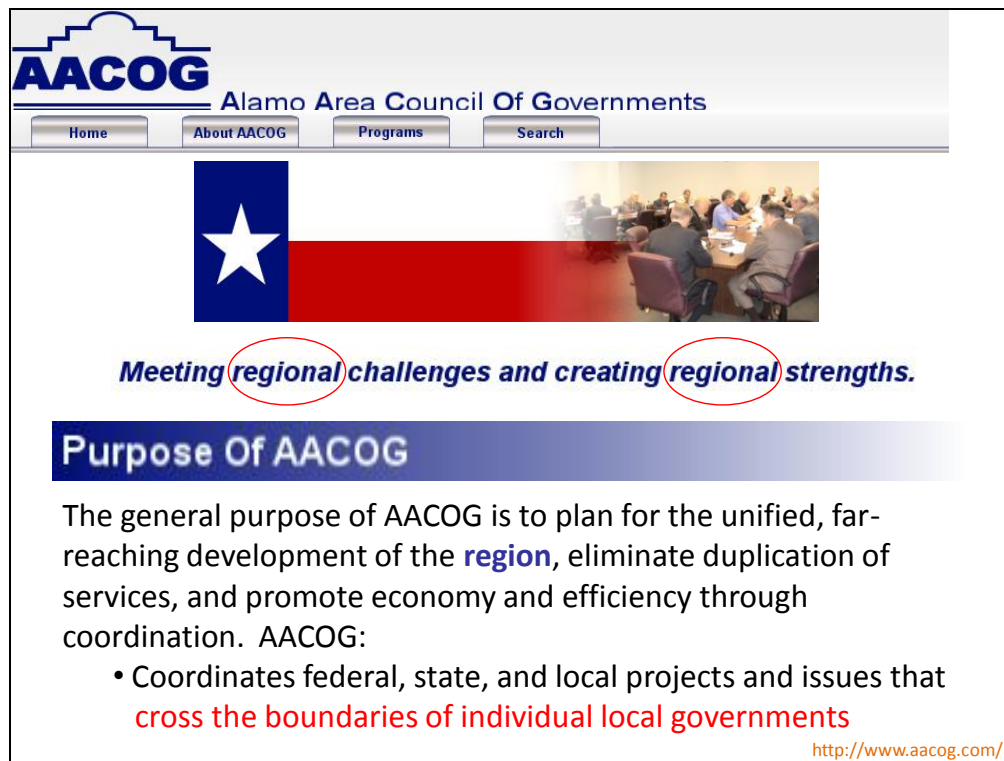

You can recognize globalism operating at the local level by recognizing the themes and programs presented by the local Action network and understanding them in the context of Agenda 21.



Regionalism practiced by the *Alamo Area Council of Governments (AACOG)* has birthed and administered the Texas Wildlands and Smart Growth policies

including the environmental, economic and transportation strategy for the 12-county *Alamo Area* that includes San Antonio. This is a prototypical Agenda 21 soviet council. The scary part is that organizations like *AACOG* are everywhere. But the battle is always local.

About MPOs: A Brief History

(Excerpts from U.S. DOT's 1988 Report, Urban Transportation Planning in the United States: An Historic Overview)

The Federal-Aid Highway Act of 1962 created the **federal requirement** for urban transportation planning... The Act required, **as a condition attached to federal transportation financial assistance**, that transportation projects in urbanized areas of 50,000 or more in population be based on a continuing, comprehensive, urban transportation planning process undertaken cooperatively by the states and local governments -- the birth of the so-called 3C, "continuing, comprehensive and cooperative planning process.




By July, 1965... qualified planning agencies to conduct the transportation planning process were lacking in many urban areas. Therefore, the Bureau of Public Roads (predecessor to the Federal Highway Administration) required the creation of planning agencies or organizational arrangements that would be capable of carrying out the required planning process. Hence, **Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs)** quickly came into being because of the growing momentum of the highway program and the federal financing of the planning process.

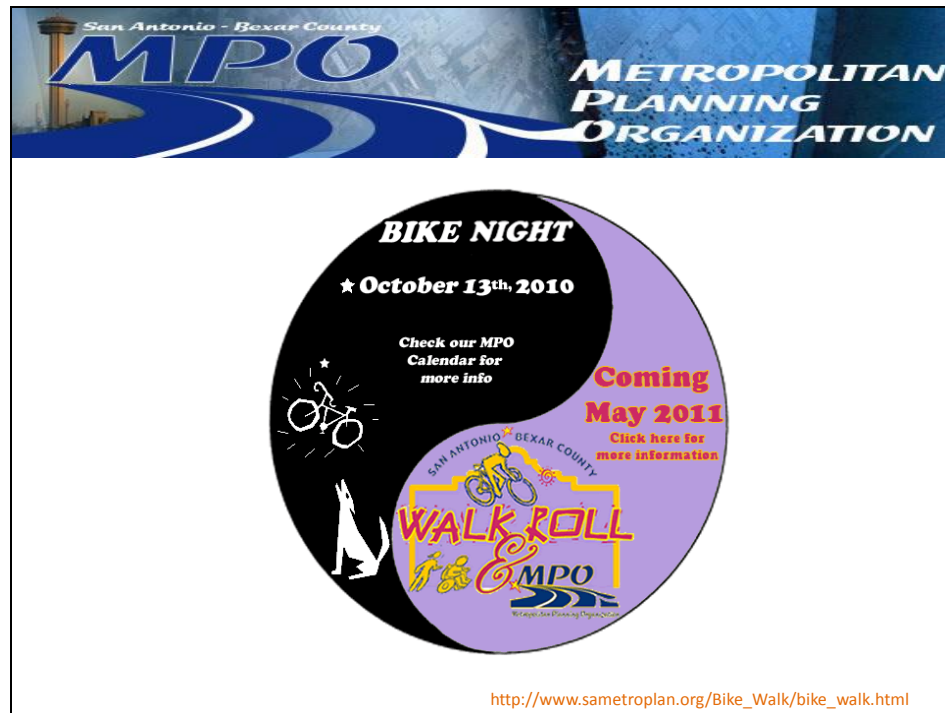

The Boltage launch included installation of a pole with a **solar-powered radio reader box on the playground**. **Students with a tag who rode a bike or scooter or walked to school pass under the pole and hear a sound that tells them their trip was counted.** ...the Boltage website, which then keeps track of their miles traveled, how many calories they have burned and how many greenhouse gases they spared the air. To further entice youngsters, the program includes incentives,... Prizes run from neon-colored stickers to bowling tickets to a new bike... that will be given to the child who has logged the most trips.


The Fifth Walk & Roll Corporate Challenge




