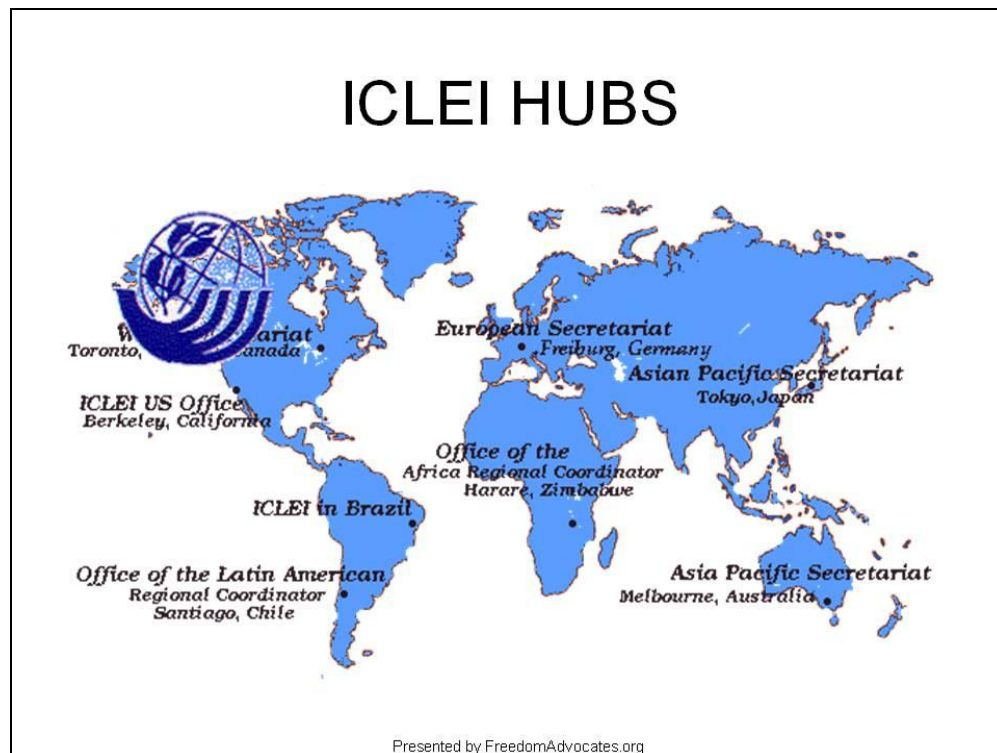

Contracts with ICLEI guarantee implementation of international political and economic policy at the local level. Drive city alliances with ICLEI out of the communities surrounding you.

So much of the Agenda 21 invasion at the local level relies on the man-made global warming fraud. But the unraveling of this masquerade has yet to hit the local

political scene. ICLEI is particularly vulnerable because of general public awareness concerning the 'man-made warming' fraud. Now *is* the time for citizens to react to ICLEI.

People around the country in places like Garland, TX, Fayetteville, AR and various cities in the Colorado plains are taking on their city's arrangement with ICLEI. ICLEI has been kicked out in Amador County, CA, Carroll County, MD, Arlington, TX and Edmond, OK. These are not the only places that are working to remove ICLEI, and the number is expanding as citizens begin to tie the links between ICLEI and the loss of freedom.

Residents across the country are using one or a combination of the following approaches to outing ICLEI:

1. Public Awareness via personal presentations and localized websites. The Colorado Plains serves as a good example. Stacy Lynne is one person working tirelessly to spread this message throughout

Colorado. Details of her efforts and successes can be found at FreedomAdvocates.org.

2. Informing elected officials on the nature of and long term effects of ICLEI involvement, including information regarding the constitutional prohibitions. Austin, TX, Edmond, OK, and Little Rock, AR are good examples. (You can watch videos of people speaking out on our website.)
3. Engage in the public initiative process with legislative provisions outlawing ICLEI and cleansing ordinances of Agenda 21 provisions. This approach is in the works in places such as Fayetteville, AR and Spokane, WA.
4. Run for office or coordinate with someone who will, with the intention of removing Agenda 21 programs. Carroll County, MD is a good example; upon election they got rid of ICLEI. (You can listen to a radio interview with Commissioner Richard Rothschild of Carroll County, MD on our website.)

Recently several other communities have decided not to renew their contracts with ICLEI. Other localized

rebellions brew. You can do this too. We are following the *Kick ICLEI Out!*, campaign at FreedomAdvocates.org.

Regionalism

Regionalism is overtaking Southern California. A federally imposed extra constitutional layer of government has been imposed. Regionalism is a core aspect of Sustainable Development. What is a Council of Governments (COG)?

COGs are region-wide associations of local governments – regional bodies, typically defined to serve an area of several counties to address issues such as regional and municipal planning, economic and community development, cartography and GIS, hazard mitigation and emergency planning, aging services, water use, pollution control, transit administration, and transportation planning. They are also sometimes called regional councils (RCs).

One LA - IAF

One LA – IAF represents a prototype Agenda 21 expression. Saul Alinsky formed the Industrial Areas Foundation (IAF). Like Acorn, IAF uses community organizing techniques.



One LA - IAF is a broad-based non-partisan organization of dues-paying member congregations, schools, unions, and nonprofits committed to building power for sustainable social and economic change.

Agenda 21 commands a one world religion based on "Gaia" (earth worship) through the values of the Earth Charter. A large number of churches have adopted community organizing as the strategy to implement the action plan of Sustainable Development. Many clergy have been drawn to community organizing because of the lures of "social justice", which is very different from the American principles of "equal justice."


The churches that have succumbed to the doctrine of "social justice" have forged a world-wide movement of interfaith organizations, some operating under an ecumenical concept. These groups often influence City Hall and use bully tactics to advance Agenda 21 programs. (This is the global to local dynamic.)

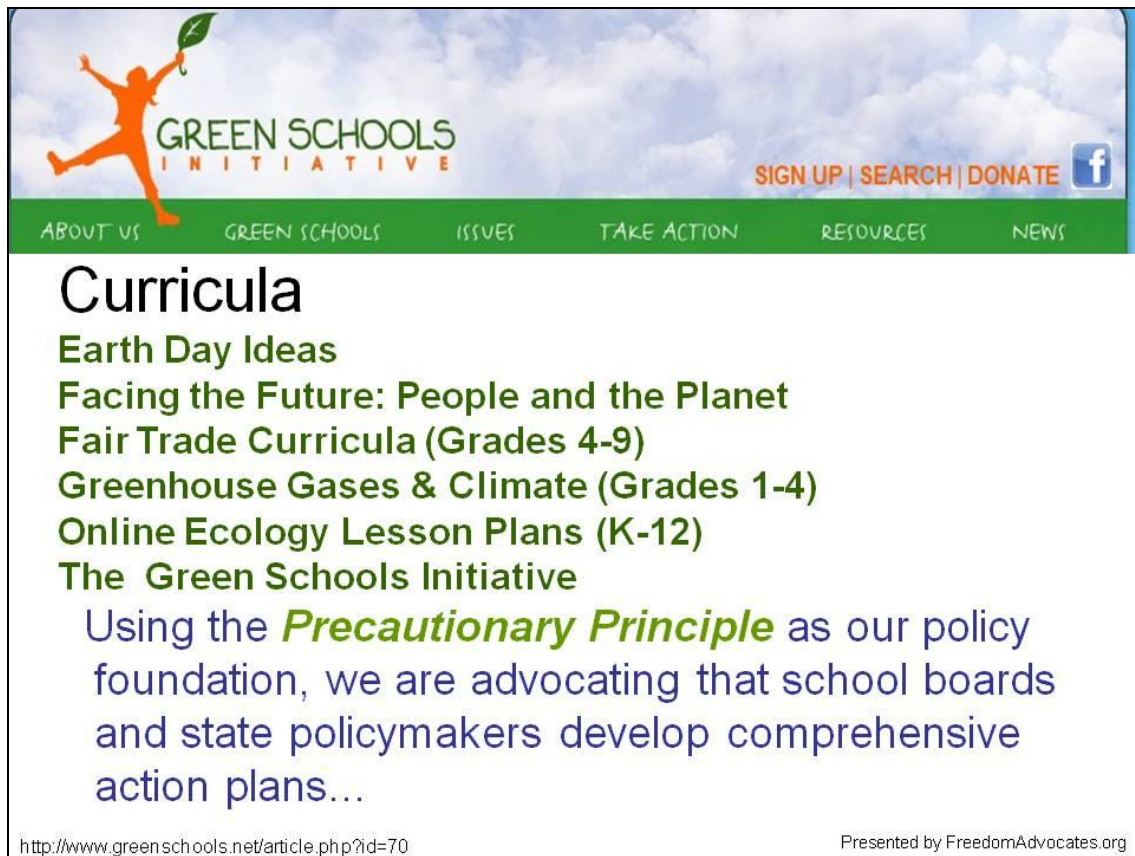

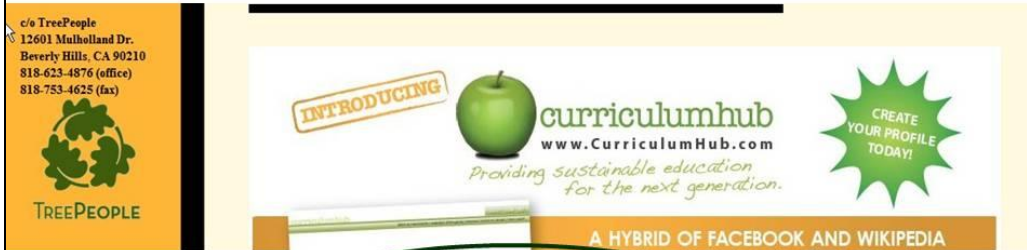
